Details of Post

Wykeham House is an Independent Day School for girls from 3-16. The School occupies a prominent position in the centre of Fareham within easy access of the M27. Over 200 girls are drawn from a wide catchment area including Fareham, Portsmouth, Southampton, Southsea, Havant, Emsworth, Hayling Island, Bishop's Waltham, the Meon Valley and Winchester. Wykeham House has an established Anglican tradition, but girls of all denominations are welcome.

At Wykeham House, we are committed to achieving academic success for each of our girls, whatever her ability. Teaching methods combine modern technology with traditional rigour. At all stages, there is much emphasis on necessary study skills, inculcating the habits that will sustain our girls throughout their time at school, and later at University or College. Classes are small which allows the frequent and easy teacher-pupil contact on which real progress and understanding so much depends.

Academic work is important, but our idea of education goes beyond the classroom. Whilst preparing our girls for the future in academic subjects, we aim to produce confident, self disciplined and motivated young women who also enjoy and excel at music, drama, sport and outdoor pursuits. An emphasis is also placed on courtesy and concern for others and girls are encouraged to take an active part in charitable work through our House system, both in the local community and further afield.

We require from September, 2012 a suitably qualified and enthusiastic person to cover maternity leave as Teacher of English working at KS4 and KS3 (about 75-80%). The ability to teach Drama would be beneficial.

The teacher will join an excellent and well resourced department which achieves outstanding GCSE results. A willingness to get involved in our extra-curricular programme is also desirable. Please look at our website for more details about the school.
